Property Maintenance

As we approach into the season of fall, I would like to remind all residents that it is their responsibility to make sure leaves are not left in the streets to be picked up by your landscape contractor at some future date. Your landscaper is responsible to pick up leaves that are blown on that day. They cannot be leftover night. The homeowner is responsible to manage their landscapers and leaf pickup.

These leaves get washed into storm drains and require a lot of DPW time and money to clean out. This also assures that storm water systems operate properly when we have heavy rains during this time. Yard waste and leaf program pickup is collected on Friday to mid-October. Branches, brush and twigs are to be bundled and tied or placed in containers, cut to 4 feet in length and not to exceed 4 inches in diameter.

Household bulk items are collected by appointment only. Call Westphal Waste Services at 201-784-2222 to make an appointment.

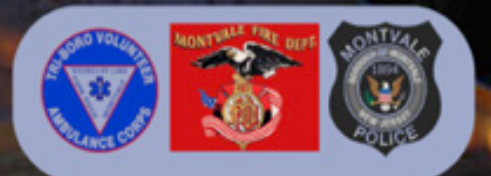

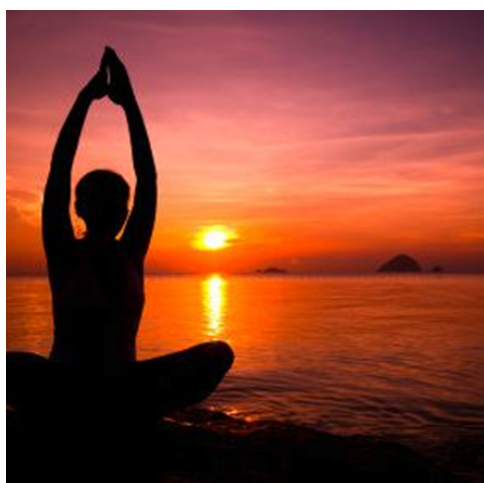

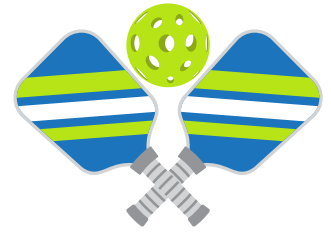

New in 2025, tennis badge registrants will receive an identifying badge rather than an access control badge to the courts. The tennis gates will not be locked at any time, but court users must be able to present a current year's badge validating that they are a current badge holder when asked by a representative of the recreation dept. The Rec Dept has moved to an identifying badge in order to alleviate continued technical issues surrounding the access control system at the tennis gate entrance. Please note that regardless of having a badge in 2024 or prior, online registrants must come into Borough Hall to pickup their new 2025 badge.
