The last of the DePiero farms is now officially owned by all of us — the people of Montvale. This is a proud moment for our community.

However, please note that approximately five acres of land still remain under private ownership as part of Montvale Landscaping, we own nine acres.

Our new community farm is a project rooted in sustainability, local agriculture, and the spirit of bringing people together. It represents a meaningful step toward preserving Montvale's rural character while creating a

space where residents can still enjoy going to the farm.

As always, preserving Montvale's character and quality of life remains a top priority. Over the past several months, the Borough Council and I have continued to stand firm against over-development. We are committed to smart, sustainable planning that respects our town's charm, protects open space, and avoids burdening our infrastructure and schools.

We are actively pushing back against outside development pressures and working to ensure that any future growth aligns with the long-term interests of Montvale residents. Your voices have been heard, and your continued support is invaluable as we navigate these challenges together.

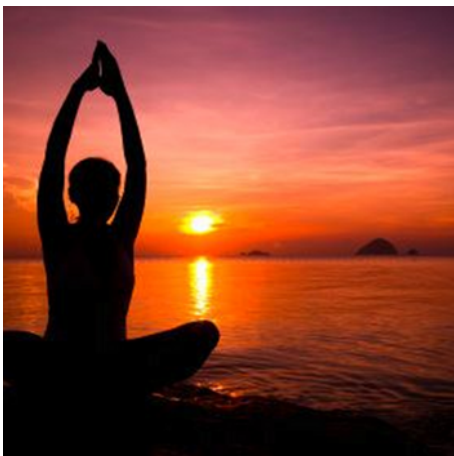

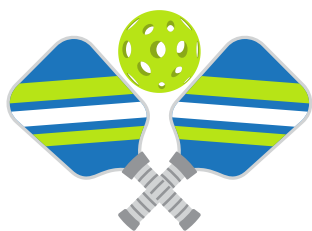

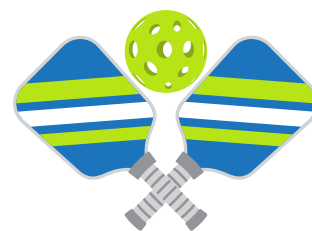

Pickleball Court Badges



Badges must be obtained prior to the use of the pickleball courts located at 1 Memorial Drive. Each year, residents and non-residents must renew their badges for the calendar year, January-December. Tennis Court Badges

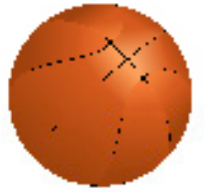

New in 2025, tennis badge registrants will receive an identifying badge rather than an access control badge to the courts. The tennis gates will not be locked at any time, but court users must be able to present a current year's badge validating that they are a current badge holder when asked by a representative of the recreation dept. The Rec Dept has moved to an identifying badge in order to alleviate continued technical issues surrounding the access control system at the tennis gate entrance. Please note that regardless of having a badge in 2024 or prior, online registrants must come into Borough Hall to pickup their new 2025 badge. Basketball Court Badges

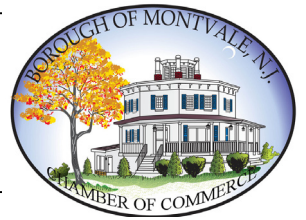
