The meeting information was posted on the website & Sunshine Law is in effect. Meeting open to the public. President Cohen asked for motion to open meeting to the public. J. Landzberg made the motion. J. Jacobson seconded the motion. All in favor.

Steven Salerno REHS presented the October reports for perusal. The September report showed no inspections and the October report only two. Clarification was sought. Percentage of students who were not immunized within the school was asked also for clarification.

President Cohen announced that M. Danna has offered to write an article regarding coyotes for the Montvale newsletter. Coyotes have become more frequent in our area and have killed several pets and bitten a resident of a neighboring town.

President Cohen informed the Board that there have been ongoing issues with senior club members not receiving blood pressure checks during the senior club meetings. G. Clark

President Cohen has recommended to NWBRHC that the nurse and senior club officers communicate directly with each other to set up and confirm meeting dates. It was also suggested that the nurse let senior club officers know when they are in the building so members know she is in the nurse's office and available for counseling.
